## President's Message

Dear Congregants:

The congregation should be very proud of what is occurring at Temple Beth Or! We are definitely turning the corner and working toward long-term sustainability. Because of your dedication and positive responses, our Kol Nidre Appeal was outstanding and your pledge increases, which amounted to just under \$10,000, were matched by our anonymous donor. Fiscal responsibility has become our mantra and knowing that our members are supporting our effort has added to the resolve of all Board members to make decisions that will be respected by our congregants.

The number of our programs has increased, the numbers attending our programs have increased, and since the summer our membership has increased. I am looking forward to the Movie Series, which will begin in January, and to the Shabbos Lunch and Learn programs also beginning in January. We are also initiating Saturday Shabbat

services that focus on the active involvement of our Hebrew School students – in addition to the monthly Youth Service. It is an absolute pleasure to be a part of this growing effort and to help in any way possible.

As I stated in the appeal letter, there are many concerns we still have for our buildings, which need to be updated to the 21<sup>st</sup> century to become more energy efficient and functional for both now and the future. For the last six months, we have worked hard to lay the groundwork to place TBO on solid financial footing. Although much work still needs to be done to accomplish this goal, we have begun to broaden our focus to include our physical home. We need to make sure that our buildings are also sustainable. To do this, we are accruing a lot of information and have been seeking expert advice so that all decisions are based on valued information and accurate data. It is my
